I. Introduction

The Central Statistical Authority (CSA) has been conducting the Rural Integrated Household Survey Program (RIHSP) since 1980/81 (1973 Ethiopian Calendar). As part of the RIHSP the rural producers' prices of agricultural products survey is being conducted on a monthly basis since May 1981 in selected Farmers' Associations; (currently Enumeration Areas, EAs).

In an effort to fulfill data users demand, the CSA has been providing price data at zone level since October 1997. This report provides information on monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products on the basis of the current administrative hierarchy, i.e., Regions and zones. Due to lack of adequate space to accommodate the data for all zones and Regions over one page, the price data of the zones and Regions are presented in six tables as follows:

Table 1 refers to monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Tigray Region at zone level (i.e., North West Tigray, Western Tigray, Central Tigray, Eastern Tigray and Southern Tigray zones) and Afar Region and two of its zones (zone 1 and zone 3)

Table 2 presents monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Amhara Region by zone (i.e., North Gondar, South Gondar, North Wello, South Wello, North Shewa, East Gojam, West Gojam, Wag Hemra, Awi and Oromiya Zones).

Table 3a presents monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Oromiya Region and its zones (i.e., West Wellega, East Wellega, Illubabor, Jimma, West Shewa, North Shewa, East Shewa, Arssi, West Harerge, East Harerge,).

Table 3b presents monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Oromiya Region and its zones (i.e., Bale, Borena, South West Shewa, Guji, Kelem Wellega, Horo Gudru Wellega, and West Arssi, Zones).

Table 4 displays monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Somali Region and three of its zones (i.e., Shinile, Jigjiga and Liben) and Benishangul-Gumuz Region and its zones (i.e., Metekel, Asosa and Kamashi zones).

Table (5a) presents monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples, SNNP, Region and its zones (i.e., Gurage, Hadiya, Kembat- Tembaro, Sidama, Gedeo, Wolayita, South Omo, Shaka, Kaffa and Gamogofa Zones).

Table (5b) refers to monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples, SNNP, Region and its zones (i.e., Bench-Maji, Yem special wereda, Amaro special wereda, Burji special wereda, Konso special wereda, Dirashe special wereda, Dawro Zone, Basketo special wereda, Konta special wereda, Siltie Zone, and Alaba special wereda).

Table 6 provides monthly average producers' prices of agricultural products in Gambella Region and its zones (i.e., zone 1, zone 2, zone 3, and zone 4), Harari Region, Dire Dawa Administrative Council and national average.

II. Objectives

The objectives of the survey are to:

- help policy makers take decisions on production and distribution of agricultural products;
- study the level of producers' price of agricultural products charged by farmers;
- study the disparities between prices at various distribution levels;
- study changes in the economy;
- help in the valuation of output for national accounts;

- Construct producers' price indices and volume of production with respect to agricultural products.

III. Scope and Coverage

The scope and coverage of the agricultural producers' price survey are constantly under review and necessary improvements are effected from time to time in an effort to incorporate commodities mostly produced by private peasants. Consequently, starting from October 1998, the number of rural enumeration areas covered in price survey is reduced from 1420 to 446. The survey currently covers about 99 selected agricultural products in about 446 Enumeration Areas at country level as compared to 65 products in 361 Farmers' Association Areas in May 1981.

The major groups of agricultural products covered by the survey include cereals, pulses, oil seeds, vegetables and fruits, potatoes and other tubers, dairy products and eggs, spices, other food items and stimulants, livestock, and hides and skins.

IV. Method of Data Collection

Agricultural producers' price is collected from private peasant households or producers' cooperatives in the selected EAs in each month of the 1st day to 15th day of European calendar since October 2008, however before that the price was collected in each month of the Ethiopian Calendar year, (October to August). Information on producers' price could only be collected from peasants or producers' cooperatives if and only if their own produce is sold during the survey month. For each agricultural product a maximum of three quantity and price quotations are collected from three different private peasants or producers' cooperatives. A Kitchen balance is used to measure the quantities sold by the producer. The data collection on producers' price is done over the 30 days of the month depending upon the work load of the enumerator and the selling habits of the producers.

V. Definitions

- **Producers' price:** Agricultural producers' price is defined as the price of the transaction carried out by the peasant/ producer at the first point of sale for a clearly specified agricultural product. In most cases this price may not correspond to the farm-gate price as the farmer sells his product at a place outside his farm.
- **Enumeration Area:** Enumeration Area in rural is a locality that is less than or equal to farmers' association areas and mostly consists of about 150-200 households.
- **Farmers' Association:-** It is the lowest administrative unit in a settled rural area with its own jurisdiction. It is an association of rural dwellers formed by the inhabitants of a given area whose members are engaged either in agricultural or non-agricultural activities.

VI. Note

- ◆ The average column provides a simple arithmetic average price for each product.
- ◆ The symbol "-" is used for data not available or doubtful.

Products in Rural Areas by Zone, 1980-1985

Table 1 shows the average producers' prices of agricultural products in rural areas by zone from 1980 to 1985. The prices are presented in US dollars per unit of product. The zones are categorized into three groups: Zone A, Zone B, and Zone C. The products included are wheat, corn, soybeans, and cotton. The prices generally show an upward trend over the period, with Zone A consistently having the highest prices and Zone C the lowest.
